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

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**THEME 1 – Meeting the Baby**  
*Primary: Pre Family Visit*

**Aims**

1. To introduce the program and motivate students' interest in the family.
2. To develop a rapport with the students and the classroom teacher.
3. To set up and explain the parameters of having a baby in the classroom.
4. To help students learn about the continuum of growth that a baby goes through, and that every baby grows at their own pace.
5. To help students understand that a baby learns through their senses such as touching.
6. To help students become aware that babies have feelings, and that they can express these feelings with their bodies.
7. To help students learn about perspective taking.
8. To establish an atmosphere of respect and caring in the classroom.

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

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## THEME 1 – Meeting the Baby Junior: *Pre Family Visit*

**Aims**

1. To introduce the program and motivate students' interest in the Baby.
2. To develop a rapport with the students and the classroom teacher and establish an atmosphere of respect and caring.
3. To set up and explain the parameters of having a Baby in the classroom.
4. To introduce information about the development of a baby's brain; to explain how brain development takes place through sensory input.
5. To help students understand that babies learn through their senses.
6. To help students understand the concept of temperament.
7. To help students understand that by observing the Baby's temperament they will learn about their own temperament and the temperament of others.
