

This checklist will guide you through the program/programme wrap-up process and contains a lot of important information so please take the time to read carefully.

Part I: Theme 9: Goodbye and Good Wishes

Plan for the following items that will be presented during Theme 9: Family Visit.

- Photo Album
- Wishing Tree (created in the Pre-Family Visit)
- Baby/Family Certificate
- Classroom treat (please discuss with your teacher in advance)
- Speeches (Who will present the gifts above to the Roots of Empathy baby/family.)
- If teaching Kindergarten, decide if the Classroom Big Book should stay in the class or school library.
- Discuss with the teacher what is to be done with items on the Bulletin Board and students' artwork/writing (see pg.2, part IV).

Part II: Feedback Forms

IMPORTANT TO NOTE: All adult and student (Gr. 3-8) forms have been revised and the current feedback forms should be completed by all program/programme participants. **Do not use** feedback forms or links from previous years.

Adult Forms:
